How do I register for a workshop?

How do I cancel my registration for a workshop?

If you’re unable to attend a workshop that you previously signed up for, you must email ThoughtSpot@travelhq.com before July 8th to request the cancellation. Cancellations received after July 8th and on-site no-shows will incur the following cancellation fees*:

- CPR – Basic Life Support - \$50 cancellation fee
